

▪ Weather

January experiences mild temperatures by Europe's standards at least but is on average the coldest month in Lisbon.

It usually gets less rain than autumn months, and there are at least some sunny days. But January weather varies: some years may be quite dry and sunny, while others are wet. Snow is non-existent.

▪ Transfer

Lisbon has a single airport, which manages all international and domestic flights.

The airport is located within the city limits and is only 6km from the historic centre.

These are the many ways to get from the Airport to the city center:

Aerobús: It leaves every 20 minutes between 7:30 am and 11 pm. This bus is a direct connection from the airport to the center of Lisbon.

Metro: Fast and inexpensive. The Lisbon metro's recent extension links the Airport with the heart of Lisbon. A single ticket costs € 1.50.


Local buses: The transport company Carris offers 5 bus routes between Lisbon Airport and the city center. A one-way ticket costs around € 2.

Taxi: A taxi is a comfortable and reasonably priced way to get from the Airport to your hotel. It normally costs around € 20 to get to the city center. We suggest that you take the taxi at the DEPARTURES entrance and NOT AT ARRIVALS.
